My first experience with the live plant of immortelle was in Corsica visiting my dear friend & her family. Down a rocky road to a small beach immortelle shined; "pick me." Back at my dear friend's house I created a medicated castor oil infusion with the dry milky wheat- like looking plant.

Along the years my friend had talked to me about the medicinal quality of immortelle for helping the dermal layer in the skin, supporting collagen production. Later, I found that it supports the reduction of scar tissue, further amplifying the benefits of castor oil.

Usage

(topical use only) for pre surgery, post-surgery when the wound is closed (sealed & healed) & for belly massage.

Be sure to add a heat medium after oil application & massage. A towel or t-shirt between you and heat medium are recommended. If heat medium is an electric pad, avoid falling asleep with it turned on.
